Participant Code of Conduct

To get the most from our WFCCP activities, we would like the children to follow these simple guidelines in our Code of Conduct:

- Timekeeping – Please arrive for training in good time, prior to the sessions starting. If running late, please make your coach aware if possible.
- Clothing – Always have the correct clothing and footwear for the pitch and weather conditions.
- Organisation – Always bring with your equipment, shin pads and a drink for the session.
- Toilets – Please try to use the toilet before or after the session. Going during the session will take up your own activity time. Please let a coach know if you need to go during a session so they are clear of your whereabouts.
- Behaviour – Good behaviour will be expected at all times. If a child shows disruptive behaviour we will speak to parents. If behaviour does not improve after this then the participant may be removed from the activity.
- Attitude – Show a good attitude and listen to the coach at all times. This is essential for both participants and coaches to get the most from the sessions.
- SMILE – We take great pride in, not only offering good quality activities, but creating a positive environment, to ensure all participants enjoy the experience and have a freedom to express themselves.
- Questions – All participants are encouraged to ask questions, therefore if any player has any questions, or issues, please feel free to speak to the particular coach, who will then address appropriately. This can either be addressed, before, during or after the session.

We hope all participants continue to enjoy and benefit from our activities. We feel by having this Code of Conduct and the above guidelines, this will help everyone to continue to enjoy and get the most out of our community sessions.
